Literacy	<ul> <li>Spelling: Learning Objective <ul> <li>To use words with /u / sound spelt as ou</li> <li>To focus on words ending in -'ing'. How do these letters join? What sound do they make?</li> <li>To explore words ending with 'ly'.</li> <li>To spell Homophones and near Homophones.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Grammar: Learning Objective <ul> <li>To use conjunctions to express time and cause.</li> <li>To punctuate direct speech.</li> <li>To place the possessive apostrophe accurately in words with regular plurals and in words with irregular plurals.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Punctuations: Learning Objective <ul> <li>To use basic punctuations to mark grammatical boundaries like commas and full stops and how they are used to join and separate clauses.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Discuss how the letters ou is pronounced as u in some words.</li> <li>For example: The ou in 'touch' sounds like the u in 'much'.</li> <li>Ask your child to copy the following sentences, underlining the letters ou when they sound like u.</li> <li>The shepherd was a young boy.</li> <li>His lies caused a great deal of trouble.</li> <li>He tricked the villagers a couple of times.</li> <li>When the wolf came, it was tough.</li> <li>Encourage your child to make note of new words and their spellings especially by adding the suffixes 'ing' and 'ly' correctly.</li> <li>Remind that conjunctions are words that join two clauses together in a sentence.</li> <li>Provide copies of texts with conjunctions and ask them to find and highlight as many different conjunctions as they can.</li> <li>Look for conjunctions when they read a book and discuss the different ways they are used in a text.</li> <li>Remind your child that, to show possession we can use an apostrophe and the letter's' just as the ned of a single noun. At the end of a plural noun that already ends in's' we add only one apostrophe. After a plural noun that does not end in's', we can use an apostrophe and the letter's' just as the ned of a single noun.</li> <li>Discuss the importance of using Punctuation marks appropriately and the effect of using them in different ways.
