To use punctuation mark accurately in complex sentences.         Image: Sentence sente	<ul> <li>Share with your child a short passage with the words ending with ance, ence, ancy and ency. Now let the students identify and highlight the words with these suffixes. After they have done ask the child to share the word hunt and now reread the passage by stressing these words.</li> <li>Talk about the Hyphens' main purpose which is to glue words together. To share with the children that we hyphenate two or more words and make them into a compound adjective or noun. Eg:- an off-campus apartment, state-of-the-art design. Ask the children to identify the use of hyphen from the text.</li> <li>Encourage your child to explore the use of complex punctuations by the writer in different ways to provide additional information to the reader.</li> <li>Comma (,) to pause, separate items in lists and to separate off extra information in a sentence. Brackets () to add extra information without distracting too much from the main idea.
