		Activity: Nature Haiku Walk: Take your child on a nature walk in a nearby park or garden. Encourage them to observe the sights, sounds, and sensations of nature around them. As you walk, prompt them to notice specific details such as the colours of the	





flowers, the rustling of leaves, or the chirping of birds. After the walk, find a quiet spot to sit and reflect on their observations. Help them compose a Haiku poem inspired by their nature walk, using the structure of three lines with a syllable pattern of 5-7-5.

Encourage your child to write a 3-line poem on their favourite season using the syllable strategy.

Talk to your child about the features of a report and emphasise the word non-fiction as report writing is based on facts.

Explore and Describe Together:

Encourage your child to pick something interesting in your home, like a favourite toy or a plant. Together, take a close look at it and talk about what you see, feel, and notice. Help your child describe it in simple words and write down their observations in a notebook or draw pictures to illustrate. Share in their excitement and encourage them to explore and describe more things around the house.

Learn and Discover as a Family:

Help your child choose a topic they're curious about, such as animals or cool facts. Spend some time reading books or looking up information online together. Share what you learn with your child and talk about the most fascinating discoveries. Encourage





		them to share their interests too and ask questions to spark their curiosity further. Write down interesting facts and create drawings or diagrams together to make learning fun and engaging.
