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



### **Venn Diagrams**

**Tell** your child that typical Venn diagram is a way of grouping different parts of data known as sets. **Use two hula hoops** to make a Venn diagram on the floor or on a large table. Give your child a group of objects and ask them to sort them into two categories, with some overlap. If a child needs more support, label the circles. **Challenge**: Out of forty students, 14 are taking English Composition and 29 are taking Chemistry.

If five students are in both classes, how many students are in neither class?


How many are in either class?
